Question No. 1

Regarding the evidence for the Business Capability fulfillment you are kindly requested to revise it in the following manner :

Evidence: List of reference and copy of invoices (or purchaser statements)

- It is acceptable to submit list of reference, copy of invoices and taking over protocols which prove qualitative and qualitative acceptance of equipment, namely fulfillment of the obligations agreed in a contract in the quality and quantity performance measures

Question No. 2

Taking into consideration the nature and the scope of personnel responsibilities and qualifications necessary to perform the contract, we think that the purchase order contract, which an employer may conclude with a particular person, based on the Article 199 of the Employment Act, should be included in the documentary evidence for the Personnel Capability. Therefore, we suggest the purchase order contract (contract on particular work) to be incorporated in documentary evidence

- It is acceptable that required personnel are engaged in accordance with Labor Law so the Bidder could submit any contract that is prescribed by Labor Law.

Question No. 3

Please modify Performance and Advance payment guarantee forms in regard to the signature. The signature of the Supplier should be removed.

- We confirm that Supplier signature is not necessary on guarantees.

Question No.4

By inspecting the TD in International open procedure for Procurement of Equipment for The Obstetrics and Gynaecology Clinic Narodni Front, Belgrade, Serbia, No. IOP/29-2019/RD for lot 8-Laboratory, item 2-Rotem, we would like to kindly draw your attention into the following:

Bearing in mind correctness of procedure and in accordance with Article 72., point 4 ZJN, we would suggest to you to add word or equivalent, to name Rotem, in accordance with provisions

of ZJN, to avoid possible misunderstandings and ambiguities with bidders, as well as the potential interference with the actual public procurement process by prospective bidders.

- Provision of Tender documents, Section I. ITB, point 18. Documents Establishing the Conformity of the Goods and Related Services, under 18.2 it is stated

18.2 The documentary evidence may be in the form of literature, drawings or data, and shall consist of a detailed item by item description of the essential technical and performance characteristics of the Goods and Related Services, demonstrating substantial responsiveness of the Goods and Related Services to the technical specification, and if applicable, a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the Schedule of Requirements.

According to that provision, it is acceptable for the Purchaser to provide equivalent device.
