CONSTRUCTION OF THE BUILDING OF THE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY OF BIOSYSTEMS (BIOSENSE) IN NOVI SAD, SERBIA (PROCUREMENT NO. IOP/43-2020/RD)

Clarification no. 2

Issued on June 16, 2020

Regarding the list of questions that the Employer, Public Investment Management Office Belgrade, No. 11 Nemanjina street, have received from the potential bidders, concerning the procurement procedure: Construction of the building of the Research and Development Institute for Information Technology of Biosystems (BioSense) in Novi Sad, Serbia no. IOP/43-2020/RD, we give you the following answers:

Question 1:

Dear Sir/Madam,

When we read the Tender Documents, in Requirements in section 2.3 Qualification Criteria, you mention that point 1.b Paticular experience, subpoint 2) and 3), the Bidder may prove fulfillment through the subcontractors, what does it mean? Does it mean that if we have subcontractor who satisfy the requirement or we can search this kind of company as our subcontractor and there shall be contract between us and the Subcontractor? And is there any other requirements about us and the Subcontractor?

Answer 1:

Statement that requirements in section 2.3 Qualification Criteria, point 1.b Particular experience, subpoint 2) and 3), the Bidder may prove fulfillment through the subcontractors, means that the Bidder is not obliged to fulfill this requirement by himself (the Bidder is not obliged to have completed the requested works by himself), but in its bid may submit a proof that some other entity, that will have a role of "a subcontractor" in the Bidder's bid, fulfills this qualification requirement (the proof that the subcontractor has completed the requested works). If the Bidder proves fulfillment of requirements under sub points 1. b 2) and 3) through subcontractor, it shall submit the documentary evidence for subcontractor listed in this point.

Subcontractors do not represent a contracting party in the contract with the Employer, but a party to which the bidder, as the contracting party with the Employer, entrusted partial execution of public procurement. Bidder shall be fully responsible to Employer for execution of obligations under public procurement procedure, i.e., for performance of contractual obligations, irrespective of number of subcontractors.

Bidder shall supply evidence on its subcontractors' fulfillment of qualification requirements in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Tender documents, Subcontractor Requirements, and tender forms regarding the subcontractors given in the Tender documents. If the Bidder intends to sub-contract part of the works under the Contract he is required to provide the details given in

the Tender Form 3.4.4. and submit relevant tender forms and documentary evidence regarding the subcontractors to which the bidder entrusted partial execution of public procurement. There is no need for submission of a specific agreement between the Bidder and the subcontractor, in terms of Employer's requirements. The contract between the Bidder and the Subcontractor might be useful for the Bidder and for the Subcontractor in order to regulate their own relations, the rights and obligations regarding the execution of the contract in question.
